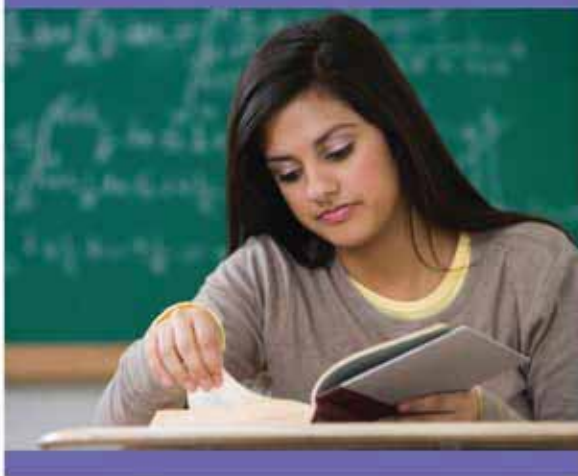

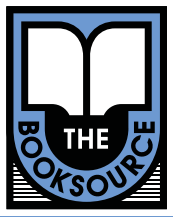

Introducing Booksource's New Classroom Libraries

In building our new classroom collections to support Common Core, you will see that we keep the structure that has been familiar to our customers from past catalogs, begin each grade level with a 50-book collection and offer smaller sets to round out and supplement the classroom library. We have worked to include texts from many different genres and cover topics that will appeal to a variety of readers.

- **Titles chosen based on new text complexity guidelines**
- **Titles offering thought-compelling book content**
- **An increased number of informational texts at all grade levels**
- **Opportunities to pair informational and literary texts on the same theme**

Text Complexity Guidelines

As described in the new Common Core standards, Lexile levels have shifted upward a bit at each grade level. Looking at the small list of text exemplars mentioned within the standards, it is clear that the content of the books is intended to challenge students on many levels. We've taken into account both the Lexile and Guided Reading levels and have placed greater focus on keeping them within the newly adjusted ranges appropriate for each grade level.

Book Content

We also paid close attention to the content of the books,

offering texts that have the kind of thought-compelling content called for in the standards. You will see fewer of the reluctant-reader titles that offer few learning opportunities and more texts that have strong curriculum connections, touch on social issues, or ask students to bring more background knowledge to their reading. We have also included books that connect to one another to help students build background knowledge and compare and contrast different texts—within each grade level, you will find sets of literary and informational texts on the same topic or covering the same historical time period.

Informational Texts

By fourth grade, 50% of student reading is supposed to be informational texts, and that percentage climbs higher as students get older. To address this, we have increased the number of informational texts across all grade levels, increasing the number of information texts in each 50-book collection as the grade levels get higher.

Whenever possible, we have also included titles and collections to address specific items mentioned in the standards. For example, in second grade, students are supposed to “compare and contrast two or more versions of the same story (e.g., Cinderella stories) by different authors or from different cultures” (RL.2.2). Standards such as these gave birth to some very specific sets. In this case, we have added to our second grade collections sets covering different variations—multicultural, fractured, and traditional versions—of Cinderella Stories, Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs, Stone Soup, and The Little Red Hen. Not all cases were as straightforward as this one, but we did this wherever and whenever the standards seemed to suggest that particular kinds of texts were needed for instruction.

Sets covering mythology, traditional tales, first person point of view, and genre studies were all created to meet these needs.

Paired Texts

Reading Standard 9 for Literary and Informational Texts asks students to compare and contrast and to integrate information from multiple texts covering the same topic or theme. The Classroom Library Extension sets we’ve created offer well-rounded sets of informational and literary texts on the same topic to make sure your classroom library has the books available to help your students synthesize ideas and information in order to meet this important standard. The variety of books in these sets will allow students to focus on the aspects of each topic they find most compelling and to select texts they find interesting.
